### A. Helmet's - Ephesians 6:17

- Helmet is used to protect the head.
- What's in your head that's important?
- The mind and the brain.
- Although Satan can't kill the soul, he can wound the mind.
- Those who are in a state of salvation have their minds covered by the cross.

### B. Salvation – John 3:16

- You can't inherit it.
- You have to choose to accept it Romans 10:9-10

### Sinner's prayer
