Coming of the Holy Spirit - Acts 2:1-13

- This is taking place on **Pentecost**
- Pentecost is also known as the feast of weeks or the feast of harvest
- The **disciples** are in Jerusalem
- Jesus foretold of this happening in Acts 1
- The way in which the Holy Spirit came was very clear
- The first thing that they see is a rushing **wind** that filled the house – Acts 2:2
- The second thing noticed was people speaking in tongues
- Next they were **filled** with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in tongues
- The spirit gave them utterance – Acts 2:4
- All of them spoke the **same** language – Acts 2:7
- This is the opposite of the tower of babel – Genesis 11:1-9

Peter's Sermon - Acts 2:14 – 41

- Peter is **speaking** to people in Jerusalem and Judea – Acts 2:14
- Peter is being directed by the Holy Spirit Preach in Jerusalem
- Peter talks about this coming from the prophet Joel – Isaiah 44:3, Joel 2:28
- Ultimately, he **preaches** the good news – Acts 2:21
- The same people that crucified Jesus are now hearing the gospel.
- The Holy Spirit used Peter and touched the hearts of the people – Acts 2:37
- After this Peter commands them to **repent** and be baptized – Acts 2:38
- After this you shall receive the Holy Spirit
- The people in Jerusalem are left with an **option** of trusting in Christ or denying Him
- We see three thousand people end up believing and coming to faith in Christ – Acts 2:41

Fellowship With Believer's - Acts 2:42 – 47

- What came afterword's was them wanting to follow after the Lord – Acts 2:42
- When someone genuinely trusts in **Christ** we generally see this being the response
- We see what is to come is fellowship among believers and a devotion to the Lord
- We see that they followed the Lord daily – Acts 2:47
- The new believers also sold there **possessions** so that everyone's needs would be filled
- We also see unity among believers - Acts 2:44
- Gods kingdom was **growing** and people were coming to know Christ – Acts 2:47
