Acts 5:1-11 – Ananias and Sapphira

- Ananias means God is Gracious
- Sapphira means beautiful.
- They had sold their property and only Gave some of it to God Acts 5:2
- When Peter asked about this they <u>lied</u> to him Acts 5:4
- Peter recognized the work of Satan in there lives
- From all outward appearance both of them had seemed to follow the Lord
- There heart was still following after sin
- They were most importantly stealing from God Malachi 3:8
- God didn't take this lightly and first killed Ananias and then killed Sapphira
- Uzzah and the Ark of the Covenant 2 Samuel 6:5-15
- Peter has still been the **main** Apostle in Acts so far

Acts 5:12-16 – The Church is Growing

- The Church is growing at a rapid rate around Jerusalem Acts 5:14
- The sick was getting **<u>healed</u>** and miracles were happening
- Many people saw the miracles and trusted in the Lord
- <u>A lot</u> of these same miracles we don't see today

Acts 5:17-32 – Arrested and Freed

- The Apostles were being persecuted John 15:20
- The High Priest arrested the Apostles Acts 5:17
- This time it wasn't just Peter and John but all the Apostles
- The High Priest was filled with Jealously
- The Apostles seem to be facing **opposition** quite often
- Anytime the truth is preached, it is normal to see opposition
- The Angel of the Lord sets these men <u>free</u> from prison
- Angels are servants who minister to us as we serve the Lord Hebrews 1:14
- They get broken out of jail at **<u>night</u>**
- The Angel told them to keep preaching Acts 5:20

Acts 5

- When **morning** arose they went back to the temple and preached
- The officers had found the guards doing their job and the prison doors locked but no one inside
- After this they got word that these people were back at the temple again preaching Acts 5:25
- The Apostles were **<u>taken</u>** back to the high priest for trial
- The Apostles started to find out that people didn't like them John 15:18
- They became afraid of being stoned
- The Apostles get brought for **trial**
- In the trial they never say the name Jesus but said "this man"
- During the trial Peter says I value what God has commanded me more than you
- Jesus says **<u>blessed</u>** are those who are persecuted for my faith Matt. 5:10

Acts 5:33-42 – The Decision

- The Sanhedrin were enraged and wanted to kill them on the spot
- There was one person that stopped this from happening and that was a <u>**Pharisee**</u> named Gamaliel Acts 5:33
- Paul being a Jew had been taught by Gamaliel Acts 22:3
- The apostles were put outside as they all talked
- Gamaliel was <u>concerned</u> because of other people who have done similar things
- They took his advice and beat the Apostles and then set them free-Acts 5:40
- They had left rejoicing and happy to be alive and this fueled there fire
- They then went on teaching and preaching wherever they went Acts 5:42
